

The fare is shewn on the taximeter, which records on a basis of time and distance at the following rates :—

- For the first two-thirds of a mile or the first seven and a half minutes
(or a combination of parts of such distance and time) - - - **9d.**
(minimum charge)
- For each additional one third of a mile or each three and three-quarter minutes (or a combination of parts of such distance and time) - - - - - **3d.**

EXTRA PAYMENTS

EXTRA PERSONS BEYOND TWO

- For each additional person (excluding infants in arms) beyond two **6d.**

NOTE :—Two children under the age of ten years count as one person.

LUGGAGE OR ARTICLES CARRIED OUTSIDE

- For each Bicycle, Perambulator or Child's Mail Cart (except when folded) - - - - - **9d.**
- For each other Article or Package - - - - - **3d.**

LUGGAGE OR ARTICLES CARRIED INSIDE

- Personal luggage *not exceeding* 2 feet in length in the form of
attache-cases, bags, satchels, parcels or other similar articles } **No Charge**
Articles of personal wear or use ordinarily carried on the person
or in the hand - - - - - }
Articles ordinarily so carried for games or sport - - - - - }
- Other Articles** (including personal luggage *exceeding* 2 feet in length)—
- For the first two - - - - - **No Charge**
- For each such article above two - - - - - **3d.**

ANIMALS

- For each basket or other receptacle containing one or more animals **3d.**
- For each animal not in a basket or other receptacle - - - - - **3d.**

Extra payments up to the sum of 2/6 must be shewn on the taximeter.
