

METROPOLITAN POLICE

FARE TABLE

The fare shown on the taximeter records on a basis of time and distance at the following rates:—	30p
For the first 900 yards (822·96 metres) or the first five minutes (or a combination of parts of such distance and time) — — — — —	(minimum charge)
For each additional 450 yards (411·48 metres) or each two and a half minutes (or a combination of parts of such distance and time) until a fare of £1·40 is shown on the taximeter — —	5p
For each additional 225 yards (205·74 metres) or each one and a quarter minutes (or a combination of parts of such distance and time) after a fare of £1·40 is shown on the taximeter — —	5p
(An extra £10 is payable each time the meter passes its limit)	

Note: The driver is not compelled to accept a hiring of more than 6 miles (20 miles in the case of a hiring beginning at London (Heathrow) Airport) or 1 hour in duration but if he does so and the journey begins and ends within the Metropolitan and/or City Police Districts the fare payable is as prescribed in this Fare Table and as shown on the taximeter.

EXTRA CHARGES

(To be shown on the taximeter unless their total exceeds the amount that can be shown on the dial.)

ADDITIONAL PASSENGERS

Each person (excluding infants in arms) beyond ONE — — — — —	5p
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Note: Two children under the age of ten years count as one person.

LUGGAGE OR ARTICLES ON DRIVING PLATFORM OR ROOF

Each article or package — — — — —	5p
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LUGGAGE OR ARTICLES CARRIED INSIDE

Personal luggage, not over 2 feet long, such as attache cases, bags, satchels, parcels or other similar articles — — — — —	}	No charge
Articles of personal wear or use normally carried on the person or in the hand or articles normally so carried for games or sport — — — — —		
Other articles (including personal luggage over 2 feet long)— For the first two— No charge. Each such article over two — — — — —		5p

ANIMALS

Each basket or receptacle containing one or more animals — — — — —	5p
Each animal not in a basket or other receptacle — — — — —	5p

NIGHT CHARGE

For each hiring beginning or ending between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. — — — — —	10p
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WEEK-END CHARGE

For each hiring beginning or ending between 8 p.m. on Friday and 6 a.m. on Monday — —	10p
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Note: When the Week-end Charge is payable, Night Charge is not payable.

PUBLIC HOLIDAY CHARGE (Payable in respect of New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Easter Monday, Spring Bank Holiday, Late Summer Bank Holiday, Christmas Day and Boxing Day only.)

For each hiring beginning or ending between 8 p.m. on the previous evening and 6 a.m. on the following morning — — — — —	20p
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Note: When the Public Holiday Charge is payable, Week-end Charge and Night Charge are not payable.
