

METROPOLITAN POLICE

Licensed Taxi-Cabs

The driver is obliged, unless he has reasonable excuse, to accept any hiring up to 6 miles (20 miles in the case of a hiring beginning at Heathrow Airport) provided that the journey begins and ends within the Metropolitan and/or City Police Districts. The fare payable for such hirings is as set out in this fare table.

Fare Table

The fare payable, on a basis of time and distance, is at the following rates:—

50p <i>minimum charge</i>	For the first 840 yards (768.10 metres) or the first four minutes (or a combination of parts of such distance and time).
10p	For each additional 420 yards (384.05 metres) or each two minutes (or a combination of parts of such distance and time) until a fare of £2.90 is shown on the taximeter.
10p	For each additional 280 yards (256.03 metres) or each one minute and twenty seconds (or a combination of parts of such distance and time) after a fare of £2.90 is shown on the taximeter.

Extra Charges (To be shown on the taximeter unless the amount exceeds that which can be shown on the dial.)

- **ADDITIONAL PASSENGERS**
Each person (excluding infants in arms) beyond ONE (two children under 10 to count as one person) _____ **10p**
- **LUGGAGE**
Each item or package carried on the driver's platform and each item or package over 2 feet long carried inside (unless normally worn or carried in the hand). _____ **5p**
- **NIGHT AND SATURDAY CHARGE**
For each hiring beginning or ending between 8 pm and 6 am Mondays to Fridays or before 8 pm on Saturdays _____ **30p**
- **SATURDAY NIGHT, SUNDAY AND PUBLIC HOLIDAY CHARGE**
For each hiring beginning or ending between 8 pm on the evening preceding and 6 am on the morning following Sundays, New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Easter Monday, the May, Spring and late Summer Bank Holidays and Boxing Day _____ **50p**
- **CHRISTMAS CHARGE**
For each hiring beginning or ending between 8 pm on 24 December and 6 am on 26 December _____ **£1**

Note: Only one of the three preceding charges shall be payable in respect of any journey.
