

METROPOLITAN POLICE

Licensed Taxi-Cabs

The driver is obliged, unless he has reasonable excuse, to accept any hiring up to 6 miles (20 miles in the case of a hiring beginning at Heathrow Airport) provided that the journey begins and ends within the Metropolitan and/or City Police Districts. The fare payable for such hirings is as set out in this fare table.

Fare Table

The fare payable, on a basis of time and distance, is at the following rates:—

50p <i>minimum charge</i>	For the first 630 yards (576.08 metres) or the first two minutes and twenty-four seconds.
10p	For each additional 315 yards (288.04 metres) or each one minute and twelve seconds until a fare of £3.60 is shown on the taximeter.
10p	For each additional 210 yards (192.02 metres) or each forty-eight seconds after a fare of £3.60 is shown on the taximeter.

Fridays or before 8 pm on Saturdays _____ **40p**
- **SATURDAY NIGHT, SUNDAY AND PUBLIC HOLIDAY CHARGE**
For each hiring beginning or ending between 8 pm on the evening preceding
and 6 am on the morning following Sundays and Public Holidays
excluding Christmas _____ **60p**
- **CHRISTMAS CHARGE**
For each hiring beginning or ending between 8 pm on 24 December and 6 am
on 26 December _____ **£2**

Note: Only one of the three preceding charges shall be payable in respect of any journey.
